If you are passionate about a career within the Building and Construction Industry upon completion of College, and would like the opportunity to participate in a pathway program during Years 11 and 12 to build your skills and capability in this industry.

The School Based Traineeship in Construction Pilot led by the Tasmanian Building Group Apprenticeship Scheme (TasBGAS) will help you achieve this.





We have been involved in the building and construction industry for over 34 years and during this time the industry has changed and so has the skills required. The industry is seeking apprentices that have greater knowledge and competency.

This school based traineeship in construction has been designed to deliver this and to fit into the demands of college life in Year 11 and 12.

We are very proud to be able to offer this opportunity and excited about the opportunity this program will provide the trainees in their skill/knowledge development.

The Project

- The program uses the Australian School Based Apprenticeship (ASbA) program, TasBGAS group training and RTO capability to successfully transition students into strong employable candidates for future apprenticeships within building and construction.
- The goal of this project pilot is to assist students to achieve their career goal of an apprenticeship and provide the building and construction industry with high quality skilled potential apprentices for their business.
- TasBGAS will be the employer and RTO of the successful trainees and provide mentoring support throughout the traineeship. This will ensure consistent management of the project and the students.
- Traineeships are being offered in across Tasmania for the pilot.
- Term of traineeship will be for Year 11 and 12: 2 Years.
- Qualification obtained will be Certificate II in Construction.

The Application Process and Selection

- ⇒ Year 10 Students who are moving to College to compete Years 11 and 12 and who seek a career in the building and construction industry can apply for a school based traineeship in Construction.
- ⇒ Project Information Sessions will be completed for students and parents regarding the detail of the pilot program, industry, expectations, assessment process plus any additional questions.
- ⇒ Applications will be assessed and students will be interviewed to assess attitude and competency as well as completing Literacy and Numeracy testing.
- ⇒ Interviews of applicants will be conducted by TasBGAS and the school will be engaged for their feedback on the applicant prior to formalisation of a traineeship offer.
